Open-Source Project provides a complete Linux-based desktop on bootable CD

Ann Arbor, Michigan, May 26, 2005 — Cybernet Systems Corporation today announced that it is sponsoring the NetMAX Desktop Project, an open-source development group that produces a full-featured desktop package based on secure Linux under the General Public License (GPL). NetMAX DeskTOP is a live-CD distribution of Linux, using the same distribution upon which Cybernet's NetMAX Server products are based.

The NetMAX Desktop distribution seeks to fill the role of a fully-functional enterprise class desktop system without licensing fees, and includes best-of-breed applications for standard desktop needs such as desktop publishing, web surfing, and multimedia features. In contrast to many other live-CD distributions, the NetMAX Desktop has been designed to be intuitive enough for non-computer savvy folks to use – and even includes integrated Windows application support. The distribution can be used on most computers without harming their contents via a bootable CD, or can be installed to a hard drive as a permanent operating system replacement.
